PhD Autumn School, Aveiro, Portugal

## 2 - 6 October 2017

The SUSPLACE Autumn School 2017 welcomes applications from **PhD candidates** and **Early Stage Researchers** with an interest in transformations to sustainability, with a particular focus on place-based development, grassroots innovations and adaptive governance.

Hosted by the <u>University of Aveiro</u>, Portugal and taking place from October 2-6, 2017, the Autumn School aims to bring together a dedicated group of participants that will work towards a shared and deepened understanding of the transformative capacity of sustainable place-shaping practices, discussing in particular:

place-based development

elopment social innovation

sustainability

grassroots initiatives

social-ecological systems

collaborative learning

transformative capacity

adaptive governance

The programme includes keynote lectures by renowned scholars as **prof. Katherine Gibson** (Western Sydney University), **prof. <u>Adrian Smith</u>** (SPRU/STEPS Centre) <u>dr. Maria Tengö</u> (Stockholm Resilience Centre), <u>prof. Celeste Coelho</u> (University of Aveiro) & <u>prof. Artur da Rosa Pires</u>

(University of Aveiro); workshops discussing theoretical approaches, concepts and methodological issues; interactive sessions in which participants present their research proceedings and get feedback from fellow students and tutors.

The fee is €300, excluding costs for travel and accommodation, but including lunches, fieldtrips, course materials and one joint dinner. The Autumn School is organised by SUSPLACE, a MSCA ITN project funded by the EU-commission that trains 15 Early Stage Researchers in innovative, interdisciplinary approaches to study and further enhance sustainable place-shaping practices.
